Tam- Volunteer coordinator

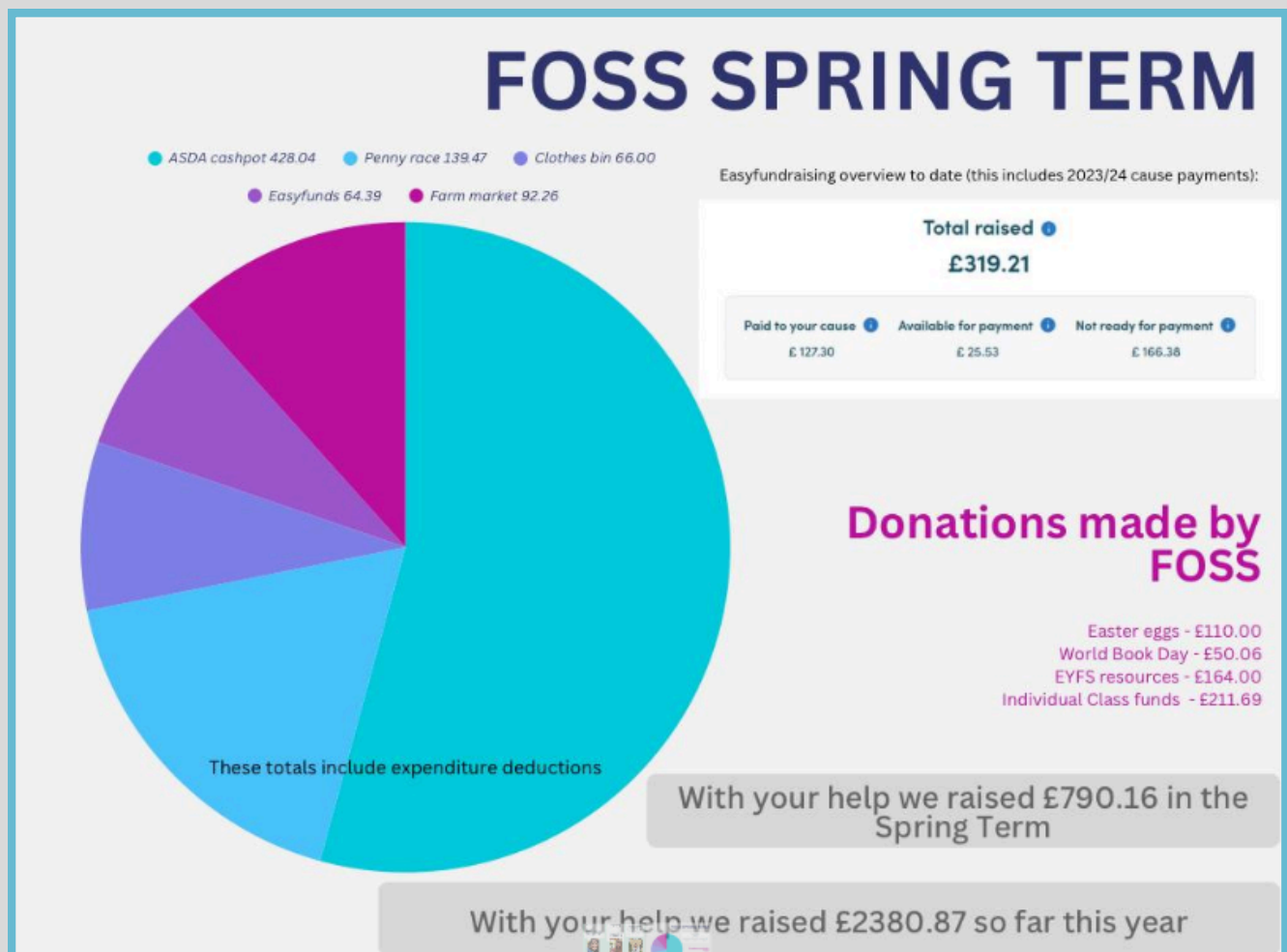
Tam is our volunteers link. She has two daughters at the school. She loves doing anything outdoors and sunrise walks on the beach are her favourite way to start the day.
