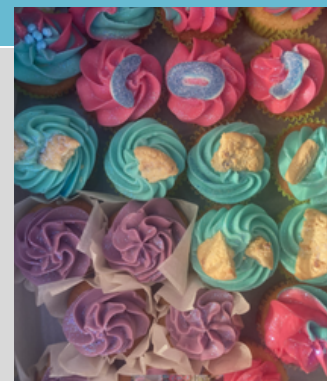

The INSET day scheduled for the 24th November 2025 will now be Monday 26th January 2026.

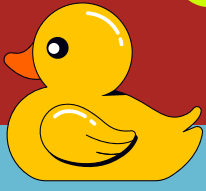
