Friday 9th December—Christingle service in St Erth Church in the afternoon, parents welcome.

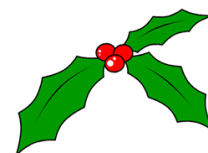
Tuesday 13th December—Treen & Mousehole Nativity in the Chapel in the afternoon, information on tickets to follow.

These will take place in School on Friday, 25 November. A letter from Kernow Health about this was attached alongside the newsletter on the website and on the email last week. It is still available on the website.

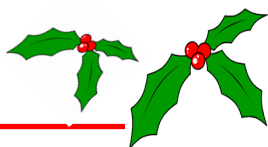
Year 5 and 6 Residential
