




Free Golf taster sessions at West Cornwall Golf Club in August

Helston Community College – RNLI Challenge 2024

Helston Community College, which is also part of Truro and Penwith Academy Trust, are holding their big fundraising challenge for 2024 event to celebrate the 200th anniversary of the RNLI and to raise funds for this vitally important charity.



Over the weekend of 13th and 14th July, some Helston staff will be completing a 90km adventure from Godrevy to Porthleven, visiting every RNLI Coastguard hut along the way. A small team will be running the coastal path over the two days, racing against a relay team who will be walking, cycling and swimming their way around. This is a massive challenge and will take lots of organisation and training. They hope to raise £13,000 to pay for an in-shore rescue boat.

In addition, they are also organising a student fun run (or walk) on the Sunday afternoon (14th July). The event will start in Helston and finish in Porthleven. The route will take students through Penrose towards Loe Bar, then along a short section of the coastal path.
