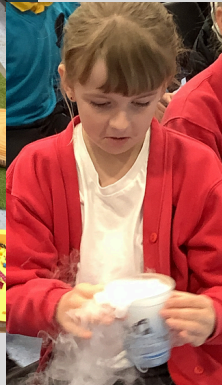
Change of INSET Day 2025/2026

There will be no netball practice after school on Monday 17th March.

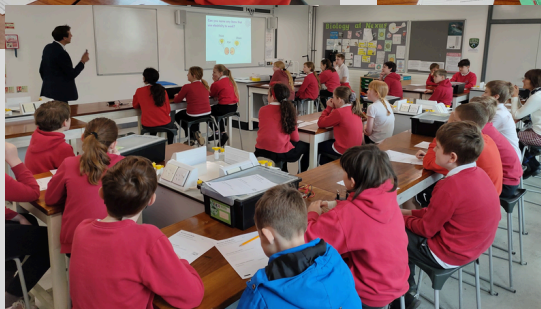
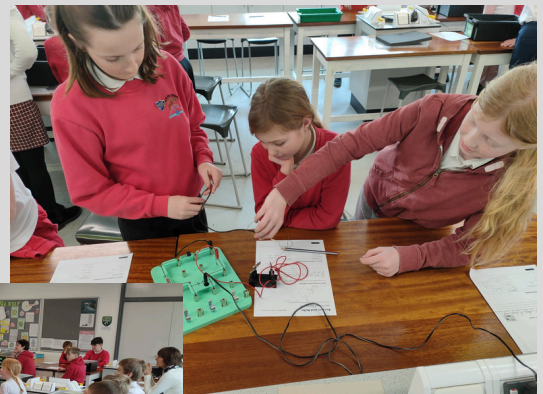

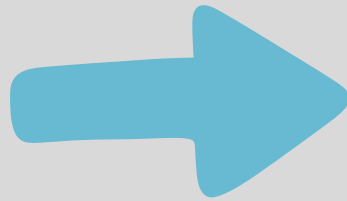
