


## Free Golf taster sessions at West Cornwall **Golf Club in August**

#### Helston Community College – RNLI Challenge 2024

Helston Community College, which is also part of Truro and Penwith Academy Trust, are holding their big fundraising challenge for 2024 event to celebrate the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the RNLI and to raise funds for this vitally important charity.



Over the weekend of 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July, some Helston staff will be completing a 90km adventure from Godrevy to Porthleven, visiting every RNLI Coastguard hut along the way. A small team will be running the coastal path over the two days, racing against a relay team who will be walking, cycling and swimming their way around. This is a massive challenge and will take lots of organisation and training. They hope to raise £13,000 to pay for an in-shore rescue boat.

In addition, they are also organising a student fun run (or walk) on the Sunday afternoon (14<sup>th</sup> July). The event will start in Helston and finish in Porthleven. The route will take students through Penrose towards Loe Bar, then along a short section of the coastal path.
