Godrevy Trip to the Maritime Museum

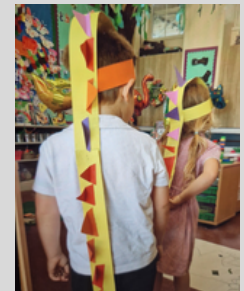
