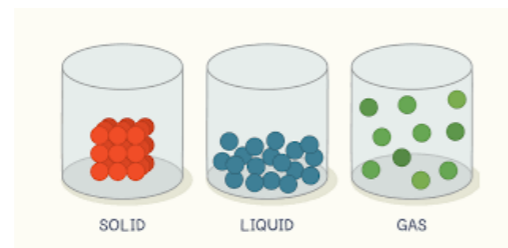
Science

Intent:
To recognise three states of matter and their properties.

Sequence of Lessons:

1. Compare and group materials in to solid, liquid or gas.
2. Ask questions about exploding pop fireworks
3. Measure the time taken for marbles to travel through different liquids
5. Observe that some materials like chocolate change state when heated or cooled.

Vocabulary
Solid, liquid, gas, particles, state, materials, properties, matter, melt, freeze, water, ice, temperature, process, condensation, evaporation, water vapour, energy, precipitation, collection.

Intent:
Children will learn and explore the Christian version of creation.

Sequence of Lessons:

1. What is wonderful about the world?
2. What does the word creation mean?
3. What can we learn about creation from the Christian story in Genesis?
4. How should humans treat the earth?
5. What can we learn about temptation from the story of 'the fall'?
6. Why do Christians pray?
