Our new topic for the Spring term is 'Imagine...' we will explore our imaginations through stories, poetry and also real events. Initially we will think about fantasy and worlds of unicorns and magic before imagining what life was like when dinosaurs roamed the Earth millions of years ago. Hopefully we will venture out on a couple of trips and as we develop our outdoor area, be able to use this space more. To support at home, please read as many stories as you can with your children and explore these imaginative worlds together.

Phonics

We will continue our Phase 4 journey through the summer. There are no new sounds to learn in Phase 4, just lots of practising of blending sounds together to become more confident in reading and writing more words using the sounds we have learnt in Phase 2 and 3. There will be some new Common Exception Words to learn to read and spell and these will be coming home too.

The children will develop their fluency in reading and their comprehension and understanding of what they have been reading independently and in guided reading in class.

Art

The children will use what they have learnt about media and materials in original ways, thinking about uses and purposes. They will represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories using a variety of materials.

Maths

Teachers:

In maths, the children will be exploring and comparing numbers to and within 20. They will learn how to count objects to 20, order and compare to 20 and how to write these numbers down before moving onto 1 more and 1 less than numbers to 20.

On Fridays, they will learn all about money and recognise coins.



<u>Music</u>

Alongside our daily singing of Nursery Rhymes to support our phonics, and listening to a range of music at the end of the day, the children will begin to compose their own music. We will record and perform this and explore different sounds for different creatures.

-Knowing the importance of having 'sensible' amounts of screen time.




<u>ICT</u>
