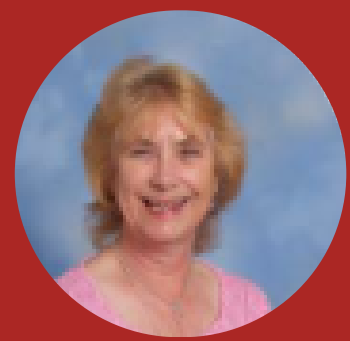


INSET DAY
