Assemblies

With Monday being widely recognized as Blue Monday our assembly this week focused on mental wellbeing with Keleigh Burgess our Education Mental Health Practitioner coming in to deliver an assembly on managing our feelings . She talked about feelings that are fun and feelings that are hard. Whilst all are normal, when we are sad or down there are things we can do. Keleigh shared 5 actions the children could take: Get active, do more of things you enjoy, get outdoors, eat healthily and to talk to someone you know and trust. In celebration assembly we discussed how we have put that into practice ourselves.

We are so proud of the progress our pupils in Treen have made with their phonics this year. We held a meeting in the Autumn term to introduce parents to our phonics scheme and offer advice on how to support at home.
