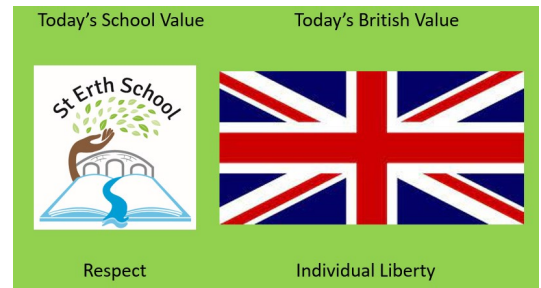

help run the stall it would be much appreciated, please let us know.

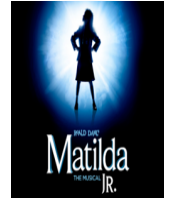


Children are bringing home a flyer today about the next 2 sessions of Messy Church which take place on Sunday, 3 March and Sunday 7 April.

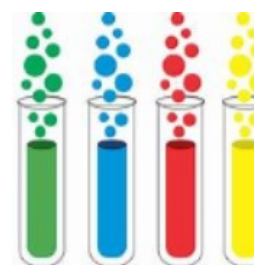
Would love to have any glossy magazines, that you may be sending to the recycling, for a collage project they will be doing next term. Thanks for your help and support.
