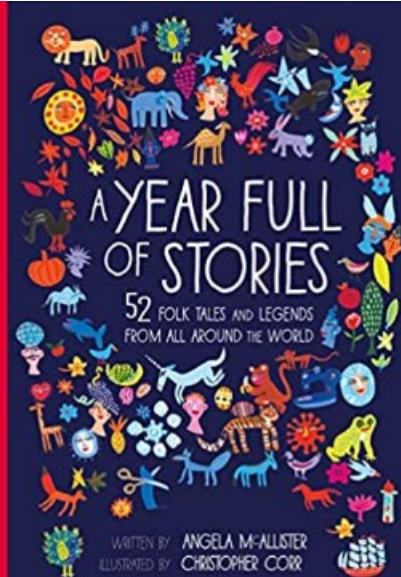


Treen Class

Maths

In maths, the children will be exploring numbers within five and becoming masters of these. They will explore one more/ one less and explore patterns within those numbers. They will also think about language associated with time and comparing lengths.

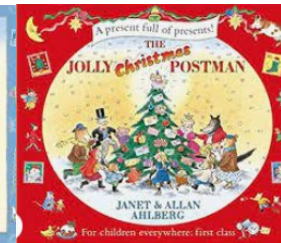
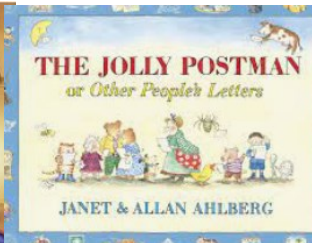
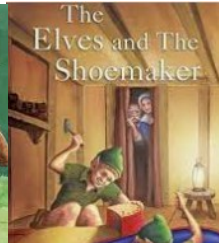
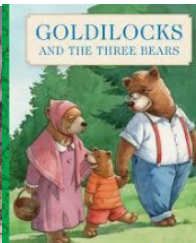
- Developing friendships within the class and how we can be kind in all situations.

Science

In Science we will be thinking about Everyday materials. The children will explore how to manipulate different materials for desired effects and explore how and why things work the way they do.

Phonics

Initially, we will spend two weeks revisiting and reviewing Phase 2 before moving on to begin our Phase 3 learning. Phase 3 introduces more digraphs and blends to unlock many more opportunities for reading. We will continue to develop writing skills alongside reading being supported by flashcards, captions and books sent home.



Art

The children will safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. This will help them create a fairy tale forest for our role play area and explore lots of different effects.

Music

We are incredibly lucky to have been chosen to take part in a twenty-week long music project with an EYFS specialist from the Cornwall Music Service Trust. We will also be practising and performing our very first Christmas show—The Bethlehem Bake Off!

ICT

The children will learn about the different parts of a computer and continue to develop their control of using a mouse. We will also explore the keyboard and being to learn about the layout of a keyboard to enable them to begin typing.

RE

The children will discuss why Christmas is important for Christians.

PE

The children will begin to play team-games and explore how taking turns in games helps games to run smoothly.
